

Did You Know

All enrolled Veterans are eligible for Homemaker Home Health Aide Care, if they are eligible for community care and meet the clinical criteria for the service. A copay for Homemaker and Home Health Aide services may be charged based on your VA service-connected disability status.

What Services Can You Get?

Services are based on your assessed needs. Talk with a VA social worker to find out what specific help you may be able to receive.

How Do You Decide that A Caregiver Is Right For You?

You can use a Veteran Decision Aid for Care at Home or in the Community to help you figure out what home care services or long term care services may best meet your needs.
